# **Continued Items:**

8.1 The 52 Ranch Tentative Tract Map No. 37756 (TTM 19-10-478) and Environmental Assessment 19-11-545 (EA 19-11-545) (Contiuned last from January 13, 2021): The project is a proposal for Tentative Tract Map No. 37756 ("TTM 37756") to subdivide approximately 34.84 acres of vacant property into new single family residential lots, common areas, and private streets. The proposed project is located 4,100 feet north of Avenue 38 on the east side of Adams Street. (Rosie Lua, Associate Planner)

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Planning Commission open the public hearing and ask for public testimony, but take no action at this time and continue the public hearing to its regular meeting of February 24, 2021, to provide additional time for the Applicant and staff to analyze the proposed TTM 37756 in relation to the City's General Plan 2040.

- 8.2 Church at the Red Door Environmental Assessment 20-05-548, Specific Plan 20-05-40, Tentative Parcel Map 20-03-403, Conditional Use Permit 20-10-1064 & Design Review 20-05-474 (Continued from January 27, 2021): The Applicant, Reverend Randy Lintecum, has filed an application with the City to develop a worship center that accommodates a combination of indoor and outdoor uses on an approximately 13.07-acre site to be located at the southeast corner of Jefferson Street and Avenue 49 (APNs: 602-060- 001 and 602-060-002). The General Plan and Zoning designations for the project site are Connected Neighborhood and Country Estates Indio Ranchos 1 (CEIR1), respectively. The Proposed Project will be built out in four phases:
  - Phase 1 will consist of the construction of a sanctuary with 580 seats with building area of approximately 25,332 square feet (SF) and 236 parking stalls, including ten (10) ADA parking stalls.
  - Phase 2 will consist of the construction of an education center (Children's Ministry Building) of approximately 6,266 SF.
  - Phase 3 will consist of the construction of an administration/education building totaling approximately 6,266 SF.

• Phase 4 will consist of the construction of a multipurpose building totaling approximately 7,277 SF, a 378 seat expansion to the sanctuary, and construction of an additional 183 parking stalls in the southeast of the project site. Upon completion, the proposed project would include a total of 419 parking stalls, 45,141 square feet building area, and 958 seats, with 220 seats within the multipurpoce room. *(Leila Namvar, Senior Planner)* 

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Planning Commission open the public hearing and ask for public testimony, but take no action at this time and continue the public hearing to its regular meeting of March 10, 2021, to provide additional time to the Applicant to work on the proposed Church at the Red Door Specific Plan.

- **10.1** <u>Chandi Square Project Consultation:</u> A project consultation to consider the architecture, site plan, circulation, and accesses for a multi-use commercial center (Chandi Square) consisting of three (3) buildings. Building A is a 5,500 square foot convenience store with a fuel canopy consisting of eight (8) fueling pumps, which is intended to operate 24 hours a day and seven (7) days a week. Building B is a 5,000 square foot drive through restaurant and retail space with an overhead structure above the drive through window area and a large overhead shade structure above the outdoor terrace area. The drive through restaurant is intended to operate 24 hours a day and seven (7) days a week. Building C is a 4,000 square foot building that includes an express tunnel for a carwash with operating hours from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm. The site is located at the southwest corner of Jefferson Street and Varner Road. *(Rosie Lua, Associate Planner)*
